Literacy

We are currently completing lots of different writing activities in order to secure our judgement for the end of Key Stage 2. We are currently focusing on David Walliam's story 'Gangsta Granny'. Through this piece of work we will write various genres of writing, including Balanced Arguments.

Towards the end of the school year, we will write a letter to a member of the Year 5 class who will be getting ready to move into Year 6 to tell them all about life in Year 6.

Religious Education

We will be learning about the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick this half-term. We will learn about the Helen and Douglas House project whilst thinking about what children and adults who are sick need to help them in their time of need.

After school on Monday 10th July, we will be visited by past pupils of St. Charles who will help us prepare for the Leavers' Mass which is on Saturday 15th July at 5:45pm.

Science
