

# ST CHARLES CURRICULUM INFORMATION - YEAR 1 SUMMER 2 2018

## English

In English lessons we will be reading texts about Robots and writing stories about robots, including recounts linked to our DT and science work and poetry. We will also be focusing on sentence structure - ensuring we can write full sentences and re-read them to check for errors. Finally, the children have their phonics screening check next week where they get to show off the amazing things they've learnt this year.

## PSHE

This half term we will complete the PSHE unit 'In the Beginning'. Children will be sent home with a booklet to complete with you and we will be working through it in class on Friday afternoons. Please ensure that the booklet is returned every Friday so that it can be used in class.

## Music

This half term we will be consolidating the learning from previous terms. We will be performing songs using instruments and our lovely singing voices. We will listen to different musical genres and look at musical features such as the pulse, tempo and pitch.

## Science

We will start our Science topic by finding out what we already know about humans. Throughout the topic we will compare our human body to that of a robot and answer the following questions:

What is our body made up of? Are all humans the same? Are humans animals?  
Are we the same as other animals? How does my body find out about its surroundings?

## RE

Our RE theme is about Reconciliation - being able to say sorry for things we have done wrong and asking for forgiveness.

We will be learning about Jesus' example and about the importance of friendships and good relationships with each other. The children will be relating this to the choices they make every day.

## PE

**PE will be on Mondays and Fridays. On Mondays we will be completing various Athletics activities and on Fridays we will be rehearsing our dance ready for the BBQ.**

*Please ensure long hair is tied back and earrings removed on PE days.*

## Maths

During maths lessons we will be consolidating what we have learnt in the previous terms. We will also learn about money, volume and capacity, Mass and Space.

## Home Learning

Children in Year 1 are asked to read their book at home every day if possible, and bring it in and change it once they have read it 3 times. Children will also be bringing spellings home each week linked to their work in phonics. These are to be practised throughout the week and the children will be tested on Fridays.
