Have a Heart Week - Creative Week

Next week is our first Creative Week of the School Year. The focus is on our Heart, how important it is to us and how we can look after it. We are also learning about the wider impact we can have on the people around us if we "Have a Heart" and use it for good. We are holding a sponsored event and raising money to fund an AED (Automated External Defibrillator) which we are hoping to position outside our school gates. This is so it can be used by the people within and around our school, should the need arise. AED's increase the risk of survival for anyone who suffers a cardiac arrest, young and old. Each class will raise money through completing different types of "jumps" during the week, and all children will also complete First Aid training so they know what to do if an emergency presents itself. Finally, we are hoping for a special visitor to come who knows how important First Aid training is and how AED's can save lives. The children should know this person from CBBC's "The Slammer" - The Guv'nor.
